Compost Collection

There is no limit to the amount of compost that can be put out for collection per household. For pick up at the curb, all compostable materials should be placed in:

- Green compost cart (maximum weight of 130 lbs/cart).
- Containers with molded handles without lids (up to a maximum weight of 50 lbs/container).
- Compostable bags, such as paper yard waste bags, (up to a maximum weight of 35 lbs/bag).

If there are non-compostable materials or branches in your compost container it will not be picked up.

Compost carts are numbered and must remain at the property to which they are assigned.

Compost Drop-off location: Just west of Landfill site entrance

Garbage Collection

Residential dwellings (Single-family, two-family & Multi-Family) are allowed 1 Garbage bag or Container (30 Gallons / 114 Litres) per week. Any bags above the limit must have a garbage bag tag. Garbage bag tags are available for \$2.00 each and may be purchased at the Altona Civic Centre. As per Workplace Health & Safety regulations, all garbage bags or containers must weigh less than 50 pounds.

Recycling Collection

There is no limit to the amount of recycling that can be put out for collection per household. For pick up at the curb, all recycling materials should be placed in:

- Blue recycling cart
- Any container that is clearly marked as recycling
